DRINKING WATER WARNING

The water system for Grandview Terrace #0036, has had a LOSS OF PRESSURE that could result in contamination of your drinking water

BOIL YOUR WATER BEFORE USING

What should I do? DO NOT DRINK THE WATER WITHOUT BOILING IT FIRST. Bring all water to a boil, let it boil for one minute, and let it cool before using, or use bottled water. Boiled or bottled water should be used for drinking, making ice, brushing teeth, washing dishes, and food preparation until further notice. Boiling kills bacteria and other organisms in the water.

The presence of bacteria indicates that the water may be contaminated with other disease-causing organisms. Microbes can cause diarrhea, cramps, nausea, headaches, or other symptoms. They may pose a special health risk for infants, young children, and people with severely compromised immune systems.

The symptoms above are not caused only by organisms in drinking water. If you experience any of these symptoms and they persist, you may want to seek medical advice. People at increased risk should seek advice about drinking water from their health care providers.

What happened? What is being done? **Grandview Terrace experienced an electrical outage due to the Hawk Fire on Saturday August 22nd which caused a loss of water pressure.**

Issue was resolve

d and power restored August 26th after 2PM As required by Northern Nevada Public Health total coliform samples will be taken to confirm the absence of bacteria in the system. We will inform you via a written rescind when you no longer need to boil your water.
